Dear Parents and Carers

Hobhouse trip to Wadebridge to walk the Camel Trail - Monday 7 July

We are planning to take the children from Hobhouse class on a school trip to the Camel Trail in Wadebridge on Monday 7 July, and we will be travelling by coach both ways.

This trip will form part of a wider topic of learning about "How does the river get to the sea?" The trip will include a walk down the Camel Trail looking at different aspects of the river. We will be completing different activities on our walk.

We would ask you to provide your child with a packed lunch (or order one from the school kitchen), water bottle, sun hat, sun cream and waterproof coat just in case of showers. We will take water to re-fill the children's bottles with should they need it. We also ask that you apply sun cream in the morning before dropping them to school and we will support them to reapply it throughout the day. The children can wear non-school uniform but must wear a Kea jumper or cardigan to make them easily identifiable. Please ensure your child wears sensible, non-slip shoes that day as they will need to be safe while walking. We suggest closed-toe shoes (no flip flops).

The coach will be leaving at 9.30 am and returning in time for the end of the school day.

There is no charge to parents as Kea School Friends have very kindly offered to fund the full amount of this trip.
