With 93 orders, and £286.40 raised, it was another amazing event.

Not being able to hold the Christmas Fayre for a second year due to the continued high number of covid cases was a disappointment. But, we supported the school's decision to not hold it, and we were so pleased how much everyone got behind our 4th virtual raffle. To try and mix it up a bit we asked different classes for different coloured gifts so we could make over 20 colourful hampers for the lucky winners. Well done to all the winners of the prizes, we hope you enjoy the contents over Christmas!

We would like to thank all the parents for their donations, especially parents who sourced gifts from their own companies. It really made a difference to ticket sales and I'm pleased to say we sold £998 worth of tickets, with all that money being profit, which directly supports our children and the school.

Behind the scenes we have also been helping Father Christmas buy and wrap over 220 gifts for the children, which they will receive at their Christmas Party this week. We've also made up their festive party props for the tables at the Christmas lunches on Wednesday.

We feel exceptionally grateful to everyone for such wonderful support this term, we have raised lots of money which will be used to support the curriculum which every child will benefit from. On the next page we have provided you with a list of the amounts we have raised since September, and what we have bought to support Kea School.

We were also extremely grateful to Kea Parish Council for our grant to support the ongoing costs for the defibrillator which is located in the car park. This is not only a great resource for school to use, but also for any emergency within the community.

As we look forward to next year we unfortunately cannot be clear what we can and cannot do. We have some great new ideas and we are desperate to get back to face to face events so we will keep all our fingers crossed!
