A really simple way to raise money for Kea School Friends without doing any work is by using Amazon Smile and Easyfundraising. Both work by donating a percentage of what you have spent when you shop online, to Kea School Friends.

Easyfundraising is an app you can download and it's FREE! Just search for "easyfundraising" in the App Store on IOS or the Google Play Store on Android. Once you have the App, simply open it and search for Kea School Friends as your chosen cause. When you shop, find the retailer you want to shop with, then shop as normal. When you check out, the retailer give us a free donation—at no extra cost to you! You can also use the App to keep track of how much you have raised.

Amazon Smile is very similar in that every time you shop through Amazon by the App, on a computer or laptop they donate a percentage to Kea School Friends. To set this up just go onto the main menu on your Amazon account and under the settings will be a sub header of amazon Smile. Simply follow the instructions and search for Kea School Friends to set up donations. If you need any help just let us know!

How KSF works

The committee usually meet every 6 weeks, but it really does depend on what events are planned. We often meet in the evenings at the pub and it's very sociable. We sometimes have sub-committee meetings to undertake different jobs for events and these are either held during school hours or the evenings. Not everyone attends all meetings, we all have busy lives so not everyone makes every meeting which is absolutely fine. With the current restrictions in place we are having to think outside the box!

If you are not sure who your class rep is your class Facebook page is a good place to enquire as most classes have these and KSF are members.

How do you decide what to spend the money on? The school put requests to the committee and we vote on what to spend our money on. We usually vote online and sometimes during our meetings— it depends when we get the request through. The school complete a form, which includes details what they want and some quotes, these go via Mrs Hunkin. When the committee are deciding whether to support a request we are told how much money we have in the bank, we also have a list of items we expect to be asked for in order to support the school throughout the year. We have also agreed to support all requests for transports costs, this supports all the children with school trips and other activities.
