Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you had a fabulous Christmas break – firstly we'd like to say a massive thank you for all your support during December. It was a crazily busy month for KSF but we raised an absolutely phenomenal of money and we have also been busy spending it! I have attached a class by class list of KSF contributions and purchases since September and I am sure you'll agree we've spent wisely with the help of Miss Warren and Staff!

One big purchase is a Community Access Defibrillator. We have purchased this in collaboration with Fleet – A frontline emergency equipment trust and supplied by Duchy Defibrillators. Both Cornish companies and they will supply, monitor and maintain the Defibrillator that is currently recognised and used by South West Ambulance Service. This will be installed over the next few months.

Fleets website states that 'Every day 250 people in the UK suffer a Sudden Cardiac Arrest, of these only 12 will survive. These are not just old and unfit people, the young and fit are just as at risk. The chance of survival depends on how quickly bystanders act. The only effective treatment for cardiac arrest is **defibrillation**, however it is vital that CPR is started as soon as possible after dialing 999. For every minute that passes with nobody doing anything, the chances of survival drop by 10%, by the time a paramedic arrives, they are fighting the odds, especially in a rural county like Cornwall'.
